Moodle

Moodle is the LMS used here at Smith College. Moodle is used to post classroom materials, create activities (such as assignments, quizzes, or forums), and store student work. Since Moodle is a FERPA compliant tool, it is the perfect place to manage students' grades and data. Moodle also helps you to set up calculations in your gradebook, making grading easier for you in the long run.

Moodle at Smith College also integrates with other on-campus tools that can enhance your classroom experience. One of those tools is Panopto, our classroom recording system that can be included in any of your Moodle courses. Another useful tool is our name pronunciation tool, NameCoach.
