## How is ScholarWorks being used at Smith?

ScholarWorks accepts a wide range of digital formats, including Open Access articles, book chapters, bibliographies, student scholarship and research - theses, dissertations and honors projects. In August 2017 there were 7891 full text downloads read by 746 institutions across 135 countries.

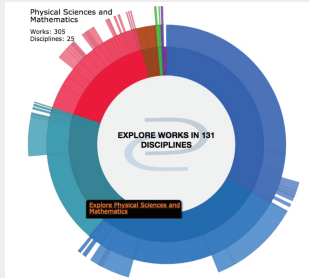

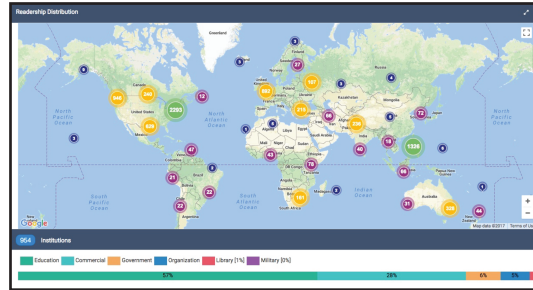
