Zoom

Zoom is a web/video conferencing tool that allows you to host one-to-one or group meetings and collaborate with colleagues and classmates on and off campus. Participants from remote locations can join Smith events and/or classes via a Zoom link. Presenters can share content and engage worldwide audiences via webinars. Zoom works across platforms and operating systems, including desktops, laptops, tablets and mobile devices.



How can Zoom be used at Smith College?

Zoom allows you to be more flexible, inclusive and engaging with how you connect with people around the world. You could record your sessions and share them with your participants, for example, record a live class for students to review or pre-record lessons for students to watch outside of class. Enhance participants collaboration with breakout rooms for group meetings and shared whiteboards. Zoom provides a way to project wirelessly from any device in Smith classrooms, providing the ability to move about the classroom.
